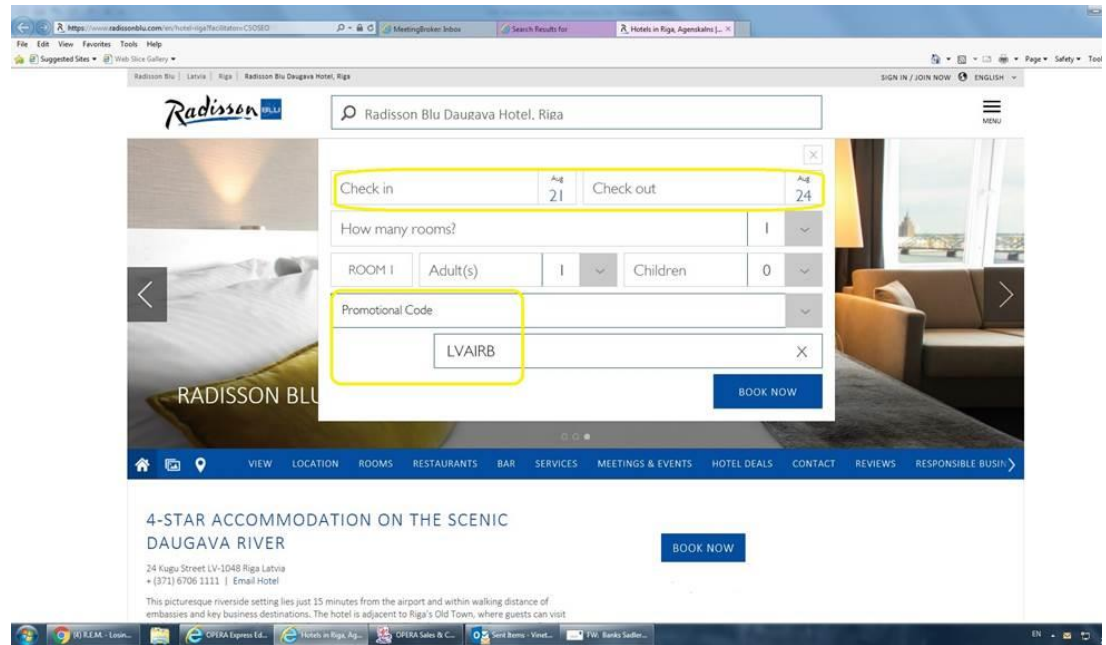

The meeting is open to all interested parties. Individuals requesting time on the agenda should contact Tom Munns. The agenda will be finalized one week prior to the meeting.

Activity Scope The scope of the activity is to develop standard interfaces that will provide airlines with freedom of choice in the installation and expansion of cabin equipment. Cabin telecommunications, cabin networks, interface protocols, and connector standardization are also a part of this activity.

Meeting Objectives The CSS and CWG will meet jointly to develop new standards and improvements for several existing standards. The following documents will be developed, discussed, or reviewed at the CSS meeting, pending completion of action items:

- Initiate work to define multi-gigabit CWAPs in ARINC 628, Part 1
- Review Draft 3 of Supplement 5 to ARINC 628, Part 9 for updated network description
- Discuss Draft 1 of ARINC Project Paper 648 to develop guidelines for seat production testing

- Review Draft 4 of Supplement 3 to ARINC Specification 664, Part 2 (define 10 Gb Ethernet interfaces)
- Discuss Draft 3 of ARINC Project Paper 836A (mini modules for equipment being installed into a modular rack concept)
- Discuss Draft 5 of Supplement 1 to ARINC Specification 800, Part 2 (hybrid (copper/fiber optic) connector, 8ax contact)
- Discuss Draft 2 of ARINC Project Paper 820 to define cabin network architectures to standardize the provisions for this equipment
- Review updated Strawman of ARINC Project Paper 854 to define implementation of 2-wire Ethernet bus for in-seat equipment.
